Academic Program

Our staff have high expectations, believe that every child matters every day, that all children can be high achievers, and adopt a wide variety of innovative, explicit teaching practices in their classrooms. As a result, the school has performed at or above expected levels over a long period of time. Staff are committed to providing a quality, well balanced education for all. Spencer Park Primary School has a strong tradition of addressing the learning needs of all students and providing learning support where needed.

Pastoral Care and Behaviour Management

Our school has a comprehensive pastoral care program which focuses on nine core values (respect, care and compassion, doing your best, kindness, honesty and trustworthiness, being environmentally kind, achieving your potential, responsibility and understanding, tolerance and inclusion). Structures that provide for the care of our students include a zero tolerance of bullying, school chaplain and mentoring program, breakfast program and a comprehensive behaviour management program.

Our case management model of pastoral care and learning support provides a wrap-around service, supporting the academic, social and emotional needs of each and every child. Our links with service providers and feeder schools are comprehensive and ensure smooth transitions. Regular meetings that involve all stakeholders and service providers, ensure a targeted approach to meeting each child's needs.



Specialist Programs

Students are involved in a range of sports, including cross country, athletics, Eagles Cup football, netball, swimming club and team sports, all supported by the school's Physical Education Specialist.

The school has a rich history of delivering arts education and offers opportunities for students to develop their knowledge of music. Additionally, extension programs are provided in the areas of choir, instrumental music, dance, drumming and art. Spencer Park Primary School hosts biennial performance productions on odd years and an art exhibition on even years. These programs and events are supported by the school's music specialist.

The school has a proud history in academic specialist programs such as the Albany Spelling Championships, PEAC and whole school 'explicit teaching approach'.

The school offers families with early entry into school with two 3 year old programs running throughout the week. One of these programs is an Aboriginal KindiLink program at our Coolangarras kindy and the other is a pre-

We are fortunate to share our campus with the Spencer Park Education Support Centre. Our co-location affords us the rich opportunity to provide integrated learning and to share knowledge and expertise with regard to learning difficulties and disabilities.
