Uncle Jono cooked some damper on the fire pit. It was Delicious!!!!

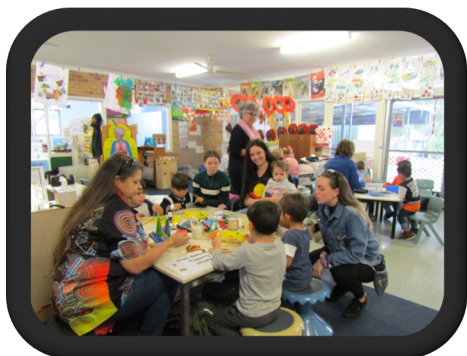


Lisa from Bunnings provided clay tiles and markers so the children could decorate them.
