Our annual Christmas Service will be held in the school hall on Tuesday 3 December at 9.45am.

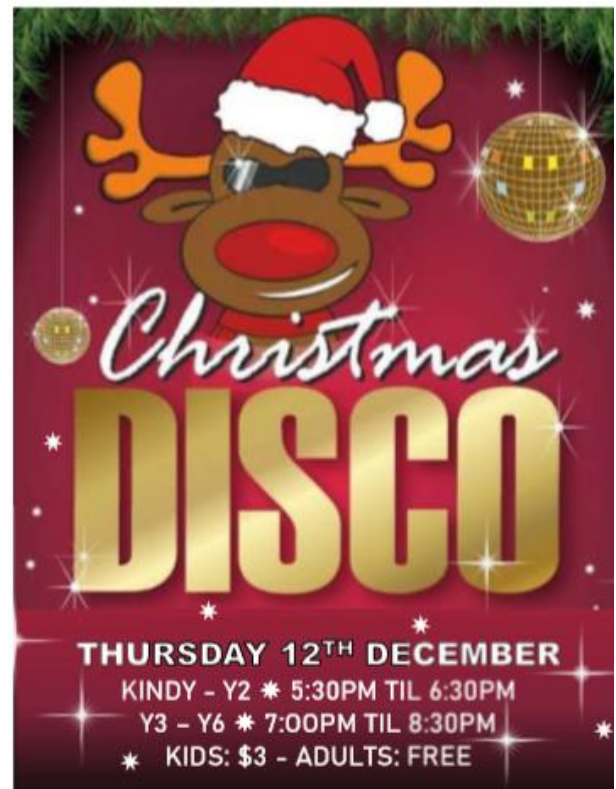


If you feel that you could donate non-perishable food items to make up hampers, there will be boxes in classes and the school office. Hampers will be distributed through the Salvation Army.
